A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT making appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The following named sums, or so much thereof
5 as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated to the
6 Supreme Court to pay the ordinary and contingent expenses of
7 certain officers of the court system of Illinois as follows:

8 For Personal Services:

9 Judges' Salaries\$186,985,300

10 For Travel:

11 Judicial Officers1,136,000

12 For State Contributions

13 to Social Security2,711,300

15 Section 10. The following named sums, or so much thereof

11 Section 30. The sum of \$26,912,700, or so much thereof
 12 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Mandatory
 13 Arbitration Fund to the Supreme Court for Mandatory
 14 Arbitration Programs.

15 Section 35. The sum of \$654,800, or so much thereof as
 16 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Foreign Language
 17 Interpreter Fund to the Supreme Court for the Foreign
 18 Language Interpreter Program.

19 Section 40. The sum of \$953,900, or so much thereof as
 20 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Lawyers'
 21 Assistance Program Fund to the Supreme Court for lawyers'
 22 assistance programs.

1 Section 45. The sum of \$500,000, or so much thereof as
2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Supreme Court
3 Special Purposes Fund to the Supreme Court for the oversight
4 and management of electronic filing, case management systems,
5 and committees and commissions of the Supreme Court.

6 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
7 2014.
