A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**  
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 1. The following named amounts, or so much  
6 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects  
7 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated from the  
8 General Revenue Fund to the Illinois Community College Board  
9 for ordinary and contingent expenses:

10	For Personal Services .....	1,047,400
11	For State Contributions to Social	
12	Security, for Medicare .....	14,400
13	For Contractual Services .....	265,800
14	For Travel .....	35,000
15	For Commodities .....	4,400
16	For Printing .....	5,300
17	For Equipment .....	3,500
18	For Electronic Data Processing .....	353,200
19	For Telecommunications .....	27,400
20	For Operation of Automotive Equipment .....	<u>3,000</u>
21	Total	\$1,759,400

1           Section 5.   The sum of \$868,400, or so much thereof as  
2   may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
3   Fund to Illinois Community College Board for costs associated  
4   with administering GED tests.

5           Section 10.   The sum of \$2,495,200, or so much thereof as  
6   may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
7   Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for costs  
8   associated with the Re-enrollment Student Program and adult  
9   education services.

10          Section 15.   The amount of \$443,100, or so much thereof  
11   as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
12   Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for Career and  
13   Technical Education Licensed Practical Nurse and Registered  
14   Nurse Preparation.

15          Section 20.   The sum of \$54,600, or so much thereof as  
16   may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
17   Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for awarding  
18   scholarships to qualifying graduates of the Lincoln's  
19   Challenge Program.

20          Section 25.   The sum of \$12,476,100, or so much thereof

1 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
 2 Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for the City  
 3 Colleges of Chicago for educational-related expenses.

4 Section 30. The following named amounts, or so much  
 5 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated  
 6 from the General Revenue Fund to the Illinois Community  
 7 College Board for distribution to qualifying public community  
 8 colleges for the purposes specified:

9	Small College Grants .....	487,400
10	Retirees Health Insurance Grants .....	0
11	Workforce Development Grants .....	0
12	Performance Funding Grants .....	<u>319,000</u>
13	Total	\$806,400

14 Section 35. The sum of \$443,100, or so much thereof as  
 15 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
 16 Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for costs  
 17 associated with the development, support or administration of  
 18 the Illinois Longitudinal Data System.

19 Section 40. The sum of \$1,321,700, or so much thereof as  
 20 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
 21 Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for grants to  
 22 operate an educational facility in the former community

1 college district #541 in East St. Louis.

2 Section 45. The following named amounts, or so much  
3 thereof as may be necessary, are appropriated to the Illinois  
4 Community College Board for all costs associated with career  
5 and technical education activities:

6	From the General Revenue Fund .....	15,569,100
7	From the Career and Technical Education Fund .....	<u>18,500,000</u>
8	Total	\$34,069,100

9 Section 50. The following named amounts, or so much of  
10 those amounts as may be necessary, for the objects and  
11 purposes named, are appropriated to the Illinois Community  
12 College Board for adult education and literacy activities:

13	From the General Revenue Fund:	
14	For payment of costs associated	
15	with education and educational-related	
16	services to local eligible providers	
17	for adult education and	
18	literacy .....	14,201,600
19	For payment of costs associated	
20	with education and educational-related	
21	services to local eligible providers	
22	for performance-based awards .....	9,483,200
23	For operational expenses of and	

1 for payment of costs associated with  
 2 education and educational-related  
 3 services to recipients of Public  
 4 Assistance, and, if any funds remain,  
 5 for costs associated with  
 6 education and educational-related  
 7 services to local eligible providers  
 8 for adult education and literacy .....4,914,800

9 From the ICCB Adult Education Fund:

10 For payment of costs associated with  
 11 education and educational-related  
 12 services to local eligible providers  
 13 and to Support Leadership Activities,  
 14 as Defined by U.S.D.O.E.  
 15 for adult education and literacy  
 16 as provided by the United States  
 17 Department of Education .....23,250,000  
 18 Total \$51,849,600

19 Section 55. The following amounts, or so much thereof as  
 20 may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated from the  
 21 Education Assistance Fund to the Illinois Community College  
 22 Board for distribution to qualifying public community  
 23 colleges for the purposes specified:

24 Base Operating Grants .....169,495,100

1	Equalization Grants .....	<u>66,966,900</u>
2	Total	\$236,462,000

3 Section 60. The sum of \$300,000, or so much thereof as  
 4 may be necessary, is appropriated from ICCB Instructional  
 5 Development and Enhancement Applications Revolving Fund to  
 6 the Illinois Community College Board for costs associated  
 7 with maintaining and updating instructional technology.

8 Section 65. The sum of \$1,000,000, or so much thereof as  
 9 may be necessary, is appropriated from the ISBE GED Testing  
 10 Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for costs  
 11 associated with administering GED tests.

12 Section 70. The sum of \$5,725,000, or so much thereof as  
 13 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Community  
 14 College Board Contracts and Grants Fund to the Illinois  
 15 Community College Board to be expended under the terms and  
 16 conditions associated with the moneys being received.

17 Section 75. The sum of \$480,000, or so much thereof as may  
 18 be necessary, is appropriated from the ICCB Federal Trust  
 19 Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for ordinary and  
 20 contingency expenses of the Board.

1           Section 80. The sum of \$1,250,000, or so much thereof as  
2    may be necessary, is appropriated from the ICCB Adult  
3    Education Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for  
4    operational expenses associated with administration of adult  
5    education and literacy activities.

6           Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,  
7    2014.
