1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 6025

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 6025, by deleting
3 everything after the enacting clause and inserting the
4 following:

5 "ARTICLE 1

6 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much
7 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects
8 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated from the
9 General Revenue Fund to the Illinois Community College Board
10 for ordinary and contingent expenses:

12	For State Contributions to Social

14	For Contractual Services	300,000

9 Section 10. The sum of \$980,000, or so much thereof as
10 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
11 Fund to Illinois Community College Board for costs associated
12 with administering GED tests.

13 Section 15. The sum of \$6,950,800, or so much thereof as
14 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
15 Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for costs
16 associated with the Re-enrollment Student Program and adult
17 education services.

18 Section 20. The amount of \$500,000, or so much thereof
19 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
20 Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for Career and
21 Technical Education Licensed Practical Nurse and Registered
22 Nurse Preparation.

1 Section 25. The sum of \$61,600, or so much thereof as
 2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
 3 Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for awarding
 4 scholarships to qualifying graduates of the Lincoln's
 5 Challenge Program.

6 Section 30. The sum of \$14,079,000, or so much thereof
 7 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
 8 Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for the City
 9 Colleges of Chicago for educational-related expenses.

10 Section 35. The following named amounts, or so much
 11 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated
 12 from the General Revenue Fund to the Illinois Community
 13 College Board for distribution to qualifying public community
 14 colleges for the purposes specified:

15	Small College Grants	550,000
16	Retirees Health Insurance Grants	0
17	Workforce Development Grants	0

20 Section 40. The sum of \$500,000, or so much thereof as
 21 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue

1 Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for costs
2 associated with the development, support or administration of
3 the Illinois Longitudinal Data System.

4 Section 45. The sum of \$1,491,500, or so much thereof as
5 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
6 Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for grants to
7 operate an educational facility in the former community
8 college district #541 in East St. Louis.

9 Section 50. The following named amounts, or so much
10 thereof as may be necessary, are appropriated to the Illinois
11 Community College Board for all costs associated with career
12 and technical education activities:

16 Section 55. The following named amounts, or so much of
17 those amounts as may be necessary, for the objects and

2 Section 60. The following amounts, or so much thereof as
3 may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated from the
4 Education Assistance Fund to the Illinois Community College
5 Board for distribution to qualifying public community
6 colleges for the purposes specified:

7	Base Operating Grants	191,271,900
8	Equalization Grants	<u>75,570,800</u>

10 Section 65. The sum of \$300,000, or so much thereof as
11 may be necessary, is appropriated from ICCB Instructional
12 Development and Enhancement Applications Revolving Fund to
13 the Illinois Community College Board for costs associated
14 with maintaining and updating instructional technology.

15 Section 70. The sum of \$1,000,000, or so much thereof as
16 may be necessary, is appropriated from the ISBE GED Testing
17 Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for costs
18 associated with administering GED tests.

19 Section 75. The sum of \$10,000,000, or so much thereof
20 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois
21 Community College Board Contracts and Grants Fund to the

1 Illinois Community College Board to be expended under the
2 terms and conditions associated with the moneys being
3 received, including prior year expenditures.

4 Section 80. The sum of \$480,000, or so much thereof as
5 may be necessary, is appropriated from the ICCB Federal Trust
6 Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for ordinary and
7 contingency expenses of the Board.

8 Section 85. The sum of \$1,250,000, or so much thereof as
9 may be necessary, is appropriated from the ICCB Adult
10 Education Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for
11 operational expenses associated with administration of adult
12 education and literacy activities.

13 Section 90. The sum of \$400,000, or so much thereof as
14 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
15 Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for a grant to
16 Rock Valley College for programs for transitioning high
17 school students.

19 Section 95. The sum of \$1,215,500, or so much thereof as
20 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
21 Fund to the Illinois Community College Board to reimburse the
22 following colleges for costs associated with the Illinois
