1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 6035

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 6035, by deleting
3 everything after the enacting clause and inserting the
4 following:

5 "ARTICLE 1

6 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much
7 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects
8 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated from the
9 General Revenue Fund to the Board of Higher Education to meet
10 ordinary and contingent expenses for the fiscal year ending
11 June 30, 2015:

12 For Personal Services2,126,000
13 For State Contributions to Social
14 Security, for Medicare30,800

1	For Contractual Services	425,000
2	For Travel	50,000
3	For Commodities	11,200
4	For Printing	8,500
5	For Equipment	10,500

9 Section 10. The sum of \$434,000, or so much thereof as
10 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
11 Fund to the Board of Higher Education for costs and expenses
12 associated with the administration and enforcement associated
13 with the P-20 Longitudinal Education Data System Act.

14 Section 15. The sum of \$208,400, or so much thereof as
15 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
16 Fund to the Board of Higher Education for costs associated
17 with the u.Select System.

18 Section 20. The following named amount, or so much
19 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General
20 Revenue Fund to the Board of Higher Education for
21 distribution as grants authorized by the Higher Education
22 Cooperation Act:

1 Quad-Cities Graduate Study Center83,900

2 Section 25. The following named sums, or so much thereof
3 as may be necessary, are appropriated from the General
4 Revenue Fund to the Illinois Board of Higher Education for
5 Science, Technology, Engineering and Math (S.T.E.M.)
6 diversity initiatives to enhance S.T.E.M. programs for
7 students from underrepresented groups:

14 Section 30. The sum of \$1,114,500, or so much thereof as
15 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
16 Fund to the Board of Higher Education for distribution as
17 grants for Cooperative Work Study Programs to institutions of
18 higher education.

19 Section 35. The sum of \$1,200,000, or so much thereof as
20 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
21 Fund to the Board of Higher Education for a grant to the
22 Board of Trustees of the University Center of Lake County for

1 the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Center.

2 Section 40. The sum of \$1,490,000, or so much thereof as
3 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
4 Fund to the Board of Higher Education for the administration
5 and distribution of grants authorized by the Diversifying
6 Higher Education Faculty in Illinois Program.

7 Section 45. The sum of \$1,500,000, or so much thereof as
8 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
9 Fund to the Illinois Board of Higher Education for the Grow
10 Your Own Teachers Program.

11 Section 50. The sum of \$425,000, or so much thereof as
12 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
13 Fund to the Board of Higher Education for competitive grants
14 for nursing schools to increase the number of graduating
15 nurses.

16 Section 55. The sum of \$224,300, or so much thereof as
17 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
18 Fund to the Board of Higher Education for nurse educator
19 fellowships to supplement nurse faculty salaries.

20 Section 60. The sum of \$100,000, or so much thereof as

1 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
2 Fund to the Board of Higher Education for the Washington
3 Center Intern Program.

4 Section 65. The amount of \$400,000, or so much thereof as
5 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Academic Quality
6 Assurance Fund to the Board of Higher Education as
7 supplemental support for costs and expenses associated with
8 the administration and enforcement of 110 ILCS 1010.

9 Section 70. The amount of \$80,000, or so much thereof as
10 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Private College
11 Academic Quality Assurance Fund to the Board of Higher
12 Education as supplemental support for costs and expenses
13 associated with the administration and enforcement of 110
14 ILCS 1005.

15 Section 75. The amount of \$550,000, or so much thereof as
16 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Private Business
17 and Vocational Schools Quality Assurance Fund to the Board of
18 Higher Education as supplemental support for costs and
19 expenses associated with the administration and enforcement
20 of the Private Business and Vocational Schools Act of 2012.

21 Section 80. The sum of \$5,500,000, or so much thereof as

1 may be necessary, is appropriated from the BHE Federal Grants
 2 Fund to the Board of Higher Education to be expended under
 3 the terms and conditions associated with the federal
 4 contracts and grants moneys received.

5 Section 85. The following named amounts, or so much
 6 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects
 7 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated from the
 8 Education Assistance Fund to the Illinois Mathematics and
 9 Science Academy to meet ordinary and contingent expenses for
 10 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2015:
