SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Makes appropriations for the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2014, as follows:

Federal Funds	\$ 65,000,000

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A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 1. The following named amounts, or so much
6 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects
7 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated to meet the
8 ordinary and contingent expenses of the Illinois Criminal
9 Justice Information Authority:

4 Section 5. The sum of \$13,950,200, or so much thereof as
5 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
6 Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority
7 for administrative costs, awards and grants for the Adult
8 Redeploy and Diversion programs.

9 Section 10. The sum of \$42,500,000, or so much thereof
10 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Criminal
11 Justice Trust Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice
12 Information Authority for awards and grants to local units of
13 government and non-profit organizations.

14 Section 15. The sum of \$15,000,000, or so much thereof
15 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Criminal
16 Justice Trust Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice
17 Information Authority for awards and grants to state
18 agencies.

19 Section 20. The following named sums, or so much thereof
20 as may be necessary, are appropriated to the Illinois
21 Criminal Justice Information Authority for activities

1 undertaken in support of federal assistance programs
2 administered by units of state and local government and non-
3 profit organizations:

4 Payable from the Criminal Justice
5 Trust Fund5,800,000

6 Section 25. The following named amounts, or so much
7 thereof as may be necessary, are appropriated to the Illinois
8 Criminal Justice Information Authority for awards and grants
9 and other monies received from federal agencies, from other
10 units of government, and from private/not-for-profit
11 organizations for activities undertaken in support of
12 investigating issues in criminal justice and for undertaking
13 other criminal justice information projects:

16 Payable from the Criminal Justice
17 Information Projects Fund1,000,000
18 Total \$2,700,000

19 Section 30. The following named amounts, or so much
20 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects
21 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated to the
22 Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority for awards,
23 grants and operational support to implement the Motor Vehicle

16 Section 35. The sum of \$10,000, or so much thereof as
17 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois State
18 Crime Stoppers Association Fund to the Illinois Criminal
19 Justice Information Authority for grants to enhance and
20 develop Crime Stoppers programs in Illinois.

21 Section 40. The following named amounts, or so much
22 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects
23 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated to the

1 Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority for the
 2 training of law enforcement personnel and services for
 3 families of homicide or murder:

4 Payable from the Death Penalty Abolition Fund:

17 Section 45. The sum of \$150,000, or so much thereof as
 18 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Prescription Pill
 19 and Drug Disposal Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice
 20 Information Authority for the purpose of collection,
 21 transportation, and incineration of pharmaceuticals by local
 22 law enforcement agencies.

23 Section 50. The following amounts, or so much thereof as

1 may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated for the
 2 objects and purposes named, to meet the ordinary and
 3 contingent expenses of the Illinois Criminal Justice
 4 Information Authority:

20 Section 55. The sum of \$1,200,000, or so much thereof as
 21 may be necessary, is appropriated from the ICJIA Violence
 22 Prevention Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice Information
 23 Authority for the purpose of awarding grants under the
 24 provisions of the Violence Prevention Act of 1995.

1 Section 60. The sum of \$820,600, or so much thereof as
2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
3 Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority
4 for the purpose of awarding grants, contracts, administrative
5 expenses and all related costs for violence prevention
6 programs.

7 Section 65. The amount of \$433,500, or so much thereof
8 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
9 Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority
10 for the Illinois Family Violence Coordinating Council
11 Program.

12 Section 70. The amount of \$217,400, or so much thereof
13 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
14 Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority
15 for all costs associated with Bullying Prevention.

16 Section 75. The amount of \$4,103,000, or so much thereof
17 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
18 Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority
19 for administrative costs and grants to the Chicago Area
20 Project.

1 Section 80. The amount of \$3,856,800, or so much thereof
2 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
3 Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority
4 for grants and administrative expenses related to Operation
5 CeaseFire.

6 Section 85. The amount of \$984,700, or so much thereof
7 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
8 Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority
9 for grants and administrative expenses for Franklin County
10 Juvenile Detention Center for Methamphetamine Pilot Program.

11 Section 90. The sum of \$145,200, or so much thereof as
12 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
13 Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority
14 for administrative costs and grants to the Chicago Area
15 Project for programs to reduce recidivism.

16 Section 999. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
17 2014.
