

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much
6 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated
7 for the objects and purposes hereinafter named, to meet the
8 ordinary and contingent expenses of the Historic Preservation
9 Agency:

1 Section 10. The sum of \$500,000, or so much thereof as
 2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
 3 Fund to the Historic Preservation Agency for all costs
 4 associated with the State Bicentennial commission.

5 Section 15. The following named amounts, or so much
 6 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated
 7 for the objects and purposes hereinafter named, to meet the
 8 ordinary and contingent expenses of the Historic Preservation
 9 Agency:

11 EXECUTIVE OFFICE

12 PAYABLE FROM ILLINOIS HISTORIC SITES FUND

13 For historic preservation programs
 14 administered by the Executive Office,
 15 only to the extent that funds are received

17 Section 20. The following named sums, or so much thereof

7 Section 30. The sum of \$150,000, or so much thereof as
8 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Historic
9 Sites Fund to the Historic Preservation Agency for awards and
10 grants for historic preservation programs made either
11 independently or in cooperation with the Federal Government
12 or any agency thereof, any municipal corporation, or
13 political subdivision of the State, or with any public or
14 private corporation, organization, or individual.

15 Section 35. The sum of \$312,227, or so much thereof as
16 may be necessary and remains unexpended at the close of
17 business on June 30, 2014, from appropriations heretofore
18 made for such purpose in Article 23, Sections 30 and 35 of
19 Public Act 98-0064, is reappropriated from the Illinois
20 Historic Sites Fund to the Historic Preservation Agency for
21 awards and grants for historic preservation programs made
22 either independently or in cooperation with the Federal
23 Government or any agency thereof, any municipal corporation,

1 or political subdivision of the State, or with any public or
2 private corporation, organization, or individual.

3 Section 40. The sum of \$150,000, or so much thereof as
4 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Historic Property
5 Administrative Fund to the Historic Preservation Agency for
6 administrative expenses associated with the Historic Tax
7 Credit Program.

8 Section 45. The following named sums, or so much thereof
9 as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects and
10 purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated to meet the
11 ordinary and contingent expenses of the Historic Preservation
12 Agency:

1 Section 50. The sum of \$275,000, or so much thereof as
 2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Historic
 3 Sites Fund to the Historic Preservation Agency for the
 4 ordinary and contingent expenses of the Administrative
 5 Services division for costs associated with but not limited
 6 to Union Station, the Old State Capitol and the Old Journal
 7 Register Building.

8 Section 55. The following named sums, or so much thereof
 9 as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects and
 10 purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated to meet the
 11 ordinary and contingent expenses of the Historic Preservation
 12 Agency:

 7 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated

13 special events, and all other costs related to the operation
14 of Illinois Historic Sites and only to the extent which
15 donations are received at Illinois State Historic Sites.

16 Section 75. The following named sums, or so much thereof
17 as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects and
18 purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated to meet the
19 ordinary and contingent expenses of the Historic Preservation
20 Agency:

12 Section 80. The sum of \$250,000, or so much thereof as
 13 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
 14 Fund to the Historic Preservation Agency for a grant to the
 15 DuSable Museum of African American History for costs
 16 associated with the Amistad Commission of Illinois.
