2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend House Bill 6133, by deleting  
3 everything after the enacting clause and inserting the  
4 following:

5 "ARTICLE 1

6 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much  
7 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects  
8 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated to meet the  
9 ordinary and contingent expenses of the Illinois Gaming  
10 Board:
