1           Section 110. The sum of \$2,770,000, or so much thereof

6           Section 115. The sum of \$2,318,300, or so much thereof  
7 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Cemetery

9 of Financial and Professional Regulation for all costs  
10 associated with administration of the Cemetery Oversight Act.

11           Section 120. The sum of \$393,700, or so much thereof as

12 expenses of the Department of Financial and Professional  
13 Regulation and the Division of Banking, or their successors,
