1 HOUSE RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, In unity, there is strength; and

3 WHEREAS, The more that local, State, and federal law  
4 enforcement agencies and operations reinforce one another,  
5 share information and resources, de-conflict operations,  
6 establish priorities, and focus energies across the spectrum of  
7 criminal activities, the more effective the outcome of separate  
8 activities undertaken by those organizations; and

9 WHEREAS, Intelligence gleaned from the collection,  
10 evaluation, analysis, and synthesis of information must be  
11 shared in order to reduce crime; and

12 WHEREAS, Collaboration encourages a coordinated and  
13 organized response to criminal activity throughout the target  
14 jurisdiction, diminishing gaps in interagency communication  
15 and intelligence; and

16 WHEREAS, Tactical intelligence is time-sensitive and  
17 crucial to the effective execution of arrests and seizures; and

18 WHEREAS, Law enforcement agencies must be able to share  
19 relevant information and intelligence across jurisdictional  
20 boundaries without risk of compromise to intelligence and the

1 operations that derive from it; therefore, be it

2 RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE  
3 NINETY-EIGHTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that  
4 we encourage the Illinois State Police, the Federal Bureau of  
5 Investigation, and the Drug Enforcement Administration to  
6 share information in order to more effectively combat crime;

9 delivered to the Illinois State Police, the Federal Bureau of  
10 Investigation, and the Drug Enforcement Administration.
