HOUSE RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, The members of the Illinois House of
3 Representatives are saddened to learn of the death of former
4 Homewood Village President and State Representative Manny
5 Hoffman of Homewood; and

6 WHEREAS, Manny Hoffman was born on February 22, 1937; he
7 graduated from Hirsch High School in 1955; he was a long-time
8 insurance agent with State Farm and owned and operated the
9 Manny Hoffman State Farm Insurance Agency in Homewood; he was a
10 lifetime member of the State Farm President's Club, an
11 organization of the company's top 50 agents nationwide; and

12 WHEREAS, Manny Hoffman was well-known for his diverse and
13 active career of service in the Homewood-Flossmor area; he was
14 president of the Homewood-Flossmor Park District's board of
15 commissioners, chairman of the Cook County Republican Party,
16 and was on the board for the Cancer Support Center, Irons Oaks,
17 and the Prairie State College Foundation; and

18 WHEREAS, Manny Hoffman was inducted into Homewood's Hall of
19 Fame in October 2008; his first office was secretary of the
20 village's volunteer fire department; he was village trustee
21 from 1977 to 1985 and mayor from 1985 to 1991; and

1 WHEREAS, The Village of Homewood named a street Hoffman Way
2 to honor his service; and

3 WHEREAS, Manny Hoffman represented the 37th District in the
4 Illinois General Assembly from 1991 to 1993; he was appointed
5 to the Illinois Labor Relations Board by Gov. Jim Edgar in 1993
6 and re-appointed to his fourth term as chairman by Gov. George
7 H. Ryan; and

8 WHEREAS, Manny Hoffman was preceded in death by his wife,
9 Judy; and

10 WHEREAS, Manny Hoffman is survived by his children, Larry,
11 Debbie, and Julie; and his grandson; therefore, be it

12 RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE
13 NINETY-EIGHTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that
14 we mourn the passing of former Homewood Village President and
15 State Representative Manny Hoffman, and we extend our sincere
16 condolences to his family, friends, and all who knew and loved
17 him; and be it further
