1 HOUSE RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, The city of Chicago continues to be afflicted with gun violence, and seniors at The Chicago High School for the Arts (ChiArts) created a temporary memorial on May 30, 2013, for all the Chicagoans who have lost their lives to gun violence since the beginning of the year; and

WHEREAS, The memorial came at a time when the culmination of the students' work on an economic project examining the causes of, and possible solutions to, the violence that plagues the city coincided with dozens of students being personally affected by the violence in Chicago; and

WHEREAS, The memorial was organized by senior Rachel Otero, who wanted to make a statement in support of her classmates who have lost friends and family to gun violence and to convey the message that they are not powerless and can use the arts to make a powerful emotional statement to address the violence; and

WHEREAS, The memorial included students tracing a chalk outline on the sidewalk in front of the ChiArts to represent each of the victims of gun violence; each victims's name was written into the outline and each name was read aloud during a candlelight vigil; and
