HOUSE RESOLUTION

2           WHEREAS, The members of the Illinois House of  
3 Representatives wish to congratulate Andrew Przybylo of Niles,  
4 Dan DiMaria of Morton Grove, and Matt Bogusz of Des Plaines on  
5 the occasion of being elected to the position of Mayor of their  
6 respective communities; and

7           WHEREAS, Mayor Andrew Przybylo is a 1969 graduate of Notre  
8 Dame College Preparatory and a 1975 graduate of Loyola  
9 University; he and his wife, Amy, have been residents of Niles  
10 since 1981; he is part owner of the White Eagle Banquets and  
11 Restaurant in Niles and is employed by Cook County as Secretary  
12 to the Cook County Zoning Board of Appeals; he served on the  
13 Niles Village Board as a Trustee from 1989 until 2013, when he  
14 was elected to serve as Mayor of Niles in April 2013; he is a  
15 board member and president of the Polish Welfare Association, a  
16 delegate to the Democratic Party Convention, and a member of  
17 the Board of Directors of First State Bank of Chicago; he has  
18 also been a member of several organizations, including the  
19 Knights of Columbus, Niles Lions Club, and Niles Sister Cities,  
20 and has served as the Democratic committeeman for Maine  
21 Township and as a commissioner for the Cook County Housing  
22 Authority; and

23           WHEREAS, Mayor Dan DiMaria is a 1985 graduate of Notre Dame

1 College Preparatory; he has served as president of DiMaria  
2 Builders and as an independent commodity trader on the Chicago  
3 Board of Trade; he has served as an Appearance Commissioner,  
4 Village Clerk, and Trustee with the Village of Morton Grove and  
5 was elected to serve as Mayor of Morton Grove in April 2013; he  
6 is also a volunteer and community-spirited person who  
7 volunteers his time at the Taste of Morton Grove, Morton Grove  
8 Days, the Chamber of Commerce, and Niles West Feeder Baseball;

10 WHEREAS, Mayor Matt Bogusz is a lifelong resident of Des  
11 Plaines and a 2005 graduate of Notre Dame College Preparatory;  
12 he is also a graduate of Northwestern University, where he  
13 gained experience in operational management, digital  
14 advertising, and media strategy; he formerly served as Alderman  
15 of the 3rd Ward and Chairman of the Engineering and Finance  
16 Committees in Des Plaines and was elected to serve as Mayor of  
17 Des Plaines in April 2013, making him the youngest person to  
18 serve in that esteemed position; he currently works for one of  
19 the world's largest brand communications and consumer contact  
20 organizations and represents Des Plaines on the Northwest  
21 Municipal Conference's Legislative Committee; and

22 WHEREAS, Andrew Przybylo, Dan DiMaria, and Matt Bogusz  
23 serve as models of hard work, integrity, and dedication for the  
24 people of the State of Illinois and are fine examples of the
