1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 15

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend Senate Bill 15 by replacing
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The Illinois State University Law is amended by
5 changing Section 20-15 as follows:

6 (110 ILCS 675/20-15)

7 Sec. 20-15. Membership; terms; vacancies. The Board shall
8 consist of 9 ~~7~~ voting members appointed by the Governor, by and
9 with the advice and consent of the Senate, and one voting
10 member who is a student at Illinois State University. The
11 student member shall be chosen by a campus-wide student
12 election. The student member shall serve a term of one year
13 beginning on July 1 of each year, except that the student
14 member initially selected shall serve a term beginning on the
15 date of his or her selection and expiring on the next
16 succeeding June 30. To be eligible to remain as a student

1 member of the Board, the student member must be a resident of
2 this State, must have and maintain a grade point average that
3 is equivalent to at least 2.5 on a 4.0 scale, and must be a full
4 time student enrolled at all times during his or her term of
5 office except for that part of the term which follows the
6 completion of the last full regular semester of an academic
7 year and precedes the first full regular semester of the
8 succeeding academic year at the university (sometimes commonly
9 referred to as the summer session or summer school). If a
10 student member serving on the Board fails to continue to meet
11 or maintain the residency, minimum grade point average, or
12 enrollment requirement established by this Section, his or her
13 membership on the Board shall be deemed to have terminated by
14 operation of law. Of the members first appointed by the
15 Governor, 4 shall be appointed for terms to expire on the third
16 Monday in January, 1999, and 3 shall be appointed for terms to
17 expire on the third Monday in January, 2001. One of the
18 additional members appointed by the Governor, by and with the
19 advice and consent of the Senate, under this amendatory Act of
20 the 98th General Assembly, shall be appointed for a term to
21 expire on the third Monday in January, 2017 and the other
22 additional member appointed by the Governor, by and with the
23 advice and consent of the Senate, under this amendatory Act of
24 the 98th General Assembly, shall be appointed for a term to
25 expire on the third Monday in January, 2019. If the Senate is
26 not in session on the effective date of this Article, or if a

1 vacancy in an appointive membership occurs at a time when the
2 Senate is not in session, the Governor shall make temporary
3 appointments until the next meeting of the Senate when he shall
4 nominate persons to fill such memberships for the remainder of
5 their respective terms. No more than 5 ~~4~~ of the members
6 appointed by the Governor shall be affiliated with the same
7 political party. Each member appointed by the Governor must be
8 a resident of this State. A failure to meet or maintain this
9 residency requirement constitutes a resignation from and
10 creates a vacancy in the Board. Upon the expiration of the
11 terms of members appointed by the Governor, their respective
12 successors shall be appointed for terms of 6 years from the
13 third Monday in January of each odd-numbered year. Any members
14 appointed to the Board shall continue to serve in such capacity
15 until their successors are appointed and qualified.
