1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 1217 2 AMENDMENT NO. . Amend Senate Bill 1217 on page 11, by replacing lines 1 through 6 with the following: 3 "(225 ILCS 25/54.3 new) 4 Sec. 54.3. Vaccinations; immunizations. Notwithstanding 5 Section 54.2 of this Act, a dentist may administer vaccinations 6 7 as a public health service upon completion of appropriate training on how to address contraindications and adverse 8 reactions. Vaccinations shall be limited to patients 10 years 9 of age and older pursuant to a valid prescription or standing 10 11 order by a physician. In addition, vaccinations shall be limited to influenza (inactivated influenza vaccine and live 12 13 attenuated influenza intranasal vaccine), Tdap (defined as tetanus, diphtheria, acellular pertussis), and shingles 14 vaccines with notification to the patient's physician and 15

appropriate record retention.".
