SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

70 ILCS 504/75 new

Amends the Central Illinois Economic Development Authority Act. Provides that the Authority may, by ordinance, designate certain territories as an Enterprise Zone under the Illinois Enterprise Zone Act in addition to any other enterprise zones that may be created under that Act. Provides that these designated territories shall have all the privileges and rights of an Enterprise Zone pursuant to the Illinois Enterprise Zone Act, but shall not be counted in determining the number of Enterprise Zones to be created in any year pursuant to that Act. Effective immediately.

1 AN ACT concerning local government.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Central Illinois Economic Development
5 Authority Act is amended by adding Section 75 as follows:

6 (70 ILCS 504/75 new)

7 Sec. 75. Enterprise zones. The Authority may by ordinance
8 designate a portion of the territorial jurisdiction of the
9 Authority for certification as an Enterprise Zone under the
10 Illinois Enterprise Zone Act in addition to any other
11 enterprise zones that may be created under that Act, which area
12 shall have all the privileges and rights of an Enterprise Zone
13 pursuant to the Illinois Enterprise Zone Act, but that shall
14 not be counted in determining the number of Enterprise Zones to
15 be created in any year pursuant to that Act.

16 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
17 becoming law.
