1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 1370

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend Senate Bill 1370 by replacing
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The Township Code is amended by changing
5 Sections 50-5 and 50-15 as follows:

6 (60 ILCS 1/50-5)

7 Sec. 50-5. Time of election and terms outside Cook County.

8 (a) Except as provided for Cook County in Section 50-10,
9 and subject to the requirements of the general election law and
10 the referendum provisions in Sections 50-25 and 50-30, at the
11 time of the regular township election provided in the general
12 election law, there shall be elected one township collector.
13 Except as provided in subsection (a) of Section 50-15, the ~~The~~
14 collector shall hold his or her office for a term of 4 years
15 and until a successor is elected and qualified.

16 (b) At the time of the regular township election provided

1 in the general election law, there shall be elected a township
2 supervisor. The supervisor shall be ex-officio supervisor of
3 general assistance. The supervisor shall hold office for a term
4 of 4 years and until a successor is elected and qualified.

5 (c) At the time of the regular township election provided
6 in the general election law, there shall be elected one
7 township clerk. The clerk shall hold office for a term of 4
8 years and until a successor is elected and qualified.

9 (d) At the time of the regular township election provided
10 in the general election law, there shall be elected by ballot
11 one township or multi-township assessor, as the case may be, in
12 the manner provided in the general election law. Except as
13 provided in subsection (c) of Section 50-15, the ~~The~~ assessor
14 shall hold office for a term of 4 years and until a successor
15 is elected and qualified.

18 Sec. 50-15. Time of entering upon duties.

19 (a) In all counties, the township collectors elected at
20 elections held prior to the 2017 consolidated election ~~the~~
21 ~~township election~~ shall enter upon their duties on January 1
22 next following their election and qualification.

23 In all counties, the term of each township collector
24 elected at the consolidated election held in 2017 shall begin
25 on January 1, 2018 and shall end on the third Monday of May

1 following the next consolidated election. Thereafter, all
2 township collectors shall serve a term of 4 years beginning on
3 the third Monday of May following their election.

4 (b) In all counties, township supervisors and township
5 clerks shall enter upon their duties on the third Monday of May
6 following their election.

7 (c) Beginning with elections in 1981 and through the
8 consolidated election held in 2013, in all counties, the
9 township and multi-township assessors shall enter upon their
10 duties on January 1 next following their election.

11 In all counties, the term of the assessor or multi-township
12 assessor elected at the consolidated election held in 2017
13 shall begin on January 1, 2018 and shall end on the third
14 Monday of May following the next consolidated election.
15 Thereafter, all assessors or multi-township assessors shall
16 serve a term of 4 years beginning on the third Monday of May
17 following their election.
