SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

210 ILCS 135/16 new

Amends the Community-Integrated Living Arrangements Licensure and Certification Act. Provides that the Department of Human Services shall establish a pilot project under which a community mental health or developmental services agency may pre-certify a community-integrated living arrangement to the Department before that living arrangement is constructed. Provides that the pre-certification must be based on a written agreement between parents or legal guardians which provides that the persons for whom those parents or guardians are responsible will reside in the living arrangement. Provides that the purpose of the pre-certification pilot project is to encourage a developer to construct a new community-integrated living arrangement for 8 residents.

3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Community-Integrated Living Arrangements
5 Licensure and Certification Act is amended by adding Section 16
6 as follows:

8 Sec. 16. Pre-certification pilot project. The Department
9 shall establish a pilot project under which a community mental
10 health or developmental services agency may pre-certify a
11 community-integrated living arrangement to the Department
12 before that living arrangement is constructed. The
13 pre-certification must be based on a written agreement between
14 parents or legal guardians which provides that the persons for
15 whom those parents or guardians are responsible will reside in
16 the living arrangement. The purpose of the pre-certification
17 pilot project is to encourage a developer to construct a new
18 community-integrated living arrangement for 8 residents.
