1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 1929

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend Senate Bill 1929 as follows:

3 on page 1, line 5, by replacing "Section" with "Sections
4 11-1301.1 and"

5 on page 1, below line 5, by inserting the following:

6 "(625 ILCS 5/11-1301.1) (from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 11-1301.1)
7 Sec. 11-1301.1. Persons with disabilities - Parking
8 privileges - Exemptions.

9 (a) A motor vehicle bearing registration plates issued to a
10 person with disabilities, as defined by Section 1-159.1,
11 pursuant to Section 3-616 or to a disabled veteran pursuant to
12 subsection (a) of Section 3-609 or a special decal or device
13 issued pursuant to Section 3-616 or pursuant to Section
14 11-1301.2 of this Code or a motor vehicle registered in another
15 jurisdiction, state, district, territory or foreign country

1 upon which is displayed a registration plate, special decal or
2 device issued by the other jurisdiction designating the vehicle
3 is operated by or for a person with disabilities shall be
4 exempt from the payment of parking meter fees until January 1,
5 2014, and exempt from any statute or ordinance imposing time
6 limitations on parking, except limitations of one-half hour or
7 less, on any street or highway zone, a parking area subject to
8 regulation under subsection (a) of Section 11-209 of this Code,
9 or any parking lot or parking place which are owned, leased or
10 owned and leased by a municipality or a municipal parking
11 utility; and shall be recognized by state and local authorities
12 as a valid license plate or parking device and shall receive
13 the same parking privileges as residents of this State; but,
14 such vehicle shall be subject to the laws which prohibit
15 parking in "no stopping" and "no standing" zones in front of or
16 near fire hydrants, driveways, public building entrances and
17 exits, bus stops and loading areas, and is prohibited from
18 parking where the motor vehicle constitutes a traffic hazard,
19 whereby such motor vehicle shall be moved at the instruction
20 and request of a law enforcement officer to a location
21 designated by the officer.

22 (b) Any motor vehicle bearing registration plates or a
23 special decal or device specified in this Section or in Section
24 3-616 of this Code or such parking device as specifically
25 authorized in Section 11-1301.2 as evidence that the vehicle is
26 operated by or for a person with disabilities or bearing

1 registration plates issued to a disabled veteran under
2 subsection (a) of Section 3-609 may park, in addition to any
3 other lawful place, in any parking place specifically reserved
4 for such vehicles by the posting of an official sign as
5 provided under Section 11-301. Parking privileges granted by
6 this Section are strictly limited to the person to whom the
7 special registration plates, special decal or device were
8 issued and to qualified operators acting under his or her
9 express direction while the person with disabilities is
10 present. A person to whom privileges were granted shall, at the
11 request of a police officer or any other person invested by law
12 with authority to direct, control, or regulate traffic, present
13 an identification card with a picture as verification that the
14 person is the person to whom the special registration plates,
15 special decal or device was issued.

16 (c) Such parking privileges granted by this Section are
17 also extended to motor vehicles of not-for-profit
18 organizations used for the transportation of persons with
19 disabilities when such motor vehicles display the decal or
20 device issued pursuant to Section 11-1301.2 of this Code.

21 (d) No person shall use any area for the parking of any
22 motor vehicle pursuant to Section 11-1303 of this Code or where
23 an official sign controlling such area expressly prohibits
24 parking at any time or during certain hours.

25 (e) Beginning January 1, 2014, a vehicle displaying a decal
26 or device issued under subsection (c-5) of Section 11-1301.2 of

1 this Code shall be exempt from the payment of fees generated by
2 parking in a metered space or in a publicly owned parking
3 ~~structure or~~ area.

6 on page 3, line 15, by replacing "structure or" with "~~structure~~
7 ~~or~~"; and

8 on page 3, line 24, by replacing "or parking structures" with
9 "~~or parking structures~~".
