1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 1955

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend Senate Bill 1955, AS AMENDED,
3 with reference to page and line numbers of House Amendment No.
4 2, as follows:

5 on page 1, line 6, after "85,", by inserting "95,"; and

6 on page 24, line 22, by replacing "3" with "2"; and

7 on page 28, immediately below line 21, by inserting the
8 following:

9 "(410 ILCS 130/95)

10 (Section scheduled to be repealed on January 1, 2018)

11 Sec. 95. Background checks.

12 (a) The Department of Agriculture through the Department of
13 State Police shall conduct a fingerprint-based criminal
14 background check of the prospective cultivation center agents.

1 Each prospective cultivation center agent shall submit his or
2 her fingerprints to the Department of State Police in the form
3 and manner prescribed by the Department of State Police. These
4 fingerprints shall be checked against the fingerprint records
5 filed in the Department of State Police and Federal Bureau of
6 Investigation criminal history records databases. The
7 Department of State Police shall furnish, pursuant to positive
8 identification, all Illinois conviction information to the
9 Department of Agriculture. The Department of State Police shall
10 be reimbursed for the cost of the background check by the
11 Department of Agriculture. ~~In order to carry out this~~
12 ~~provision, each person applying as a cultivation center agent~~
13 ~~shall submit a full set of fingerprints to the Department of~~
14 ~~Agriculture for the purpose of obtaining a State and federal~~
15 ~~criminal records check. The Department of Agriculture may~~
16 ~~exchange this data with the Department of State Police and the~~
17 ~~Federal Bureau of Investigation without disclosing that the~~
18 ~~records check is related to this Act. The Department of~~
19 ~~Agriculture shall destroy each set of fingerprints after the~~
20 ~~criminal records check is complete.~~

21 (b) When applying for the initial permit, the background
22 checks for the principal officer, board members, and registered
23 agents shall be completed prior to submitting the application
24 to the Department of Agriculture.

3 "Regulation shall conduct a fingerprint-based criminal
4 background check of the prospective dispensing organization
5 agents in order to carry out this provision. Each prospective
6 dispensing organization agent shall submit his or her
7 fingerprints to the Department of State Police in the form and
8 manner prescribed by the Department of State Police. These
9 fingerprints shall be checked against the fingerprint records
10 filed in the Department of State Police and Federal Bureau of
11 Investigation criminal history records databases. The
12 Department of State Police shall furnish, pursuant to positive
13 identification, all Illinois conviction information to the
14 Department of Financial and Professional Regulation. The
15 Department of State Police shall be reimbursed for the cost of
16 the background check by the Department of Financial and
17 Professional Regulation. ~~Each person applying as a dispensing~~
18 ~~organization agent shall submit a full set of fingerprints to~~
