SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

105 ILCS 5/34-18.48 new

Amends the Chicago School District Article of the School Code. Provides that students of the district shall take 4 standardized academic achievement tests per school year and must not be required to take more than that number. Provide that the 4 tests shall consist of 2 State tests and 2 tests to comply with the Evaluation of Employees Article of the Code. Effective July 1, 2013.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The School Code is amended by adding Section
5 34-18.48 as follows:

6 (105 ILCS 5/34-18.48 new)

7 Sec. 34-18.48. Limit on number of standardized tests.
8 Students of the school district shall take 4 standardized
9 academic achievement tests per school year and must not be
10 required to take more than that number. The 4 tests shall
11 consist of 2 State tests and 2 tests to comply with Article 24A
12 of this Code.

13 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
14 2013.
