

1 AN ACT concerning local government.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Illinois Municipal Code is amended by
5 changing Section 1-2-11 as follows:

6 (65 ILCS 5/1-2-11) (from Ch. 24, par. 1-2-11)

7 Sec. 1-2-11. (a) A sheriff may serve any process or make
8 any arrest in a municipality or a part of a municipality
9 located in the county in which the sheriff was elected that any
10 officer of that municipality is authorized to make under this
11 Code or any ordinance passed under this Code.

12 (b) Police officers may serve summons for violations of
13 ordinances occurring within their municipalities. In
14 municipalities with a population of 1,000,000 or more, active
15 duty or retired police officers may serve summons for
16 violations of ordinances occurring within their
17 municipalities.

18 (c) In addition to the powers stated in Section 8.1a of the
19 Housing Authorities Act, in counties with a population of
20 3,000,000 or more inhabitants, members of a housing authority
21 police force may serve process for forcible entry and detainer
22 actions commenced by that housing authority and may execute
23 orders of possession for that housing authority.
