1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 2404

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend Senate Bill 2404, AS AMENDED,
3 as follows:

4 in Section 30, in Sec. 2-126, by inserting after the end of
5 subsection (a-5) the following:

6 "(a-10) Notwithstanding any other provision of this
7 Section, if for any fiscal year the General Assembly reduces
8 the guaranteed funding formula or the available appropriations
9 are insufficient to provide the amount required under that
10 funding formula, then in that same fiscal year all employee
11 contributions required under this Section shall be reduced by
12 the same percentage as the percentage by which the guaranteed
13 State funding or available appropriation was reduced below the
14 amount required under that funding formula as initially
15 certified by the System for that fiscal year.

16 If a court orders the State to pay full payment under the
17 guaranteed funding formula, or if a supplemental appropriation

1 sufficient to provide the amount required under that funding
2 formula is enacted, then upon the first payment by the State at
3 the level required by that funding formula, the required
4 employee contribution rate shall return to the unreduced
5 amount.

6 At the beginning of each fiscal year, the Commission on
7 Government Forecasting and Accountability shall determine
8 whether this subsection applies and, if so, the amount of the
9 percentage reduction in employee contributions that shall be
10 made under this subsection.

11 For the purposes of this subsection, "guaranteed funding
12 formula" means the formula for the calculation of the required
13 State contribution in Section 2-124 of this Code, as that
14 Section existed immediately before the effective date of this
15 amendatory Act of the 98th General Assembly."; and

16 in Section 30, in Sec. 14-133, by inserting after the end of
17 subsection (a-5) the following:

18 "(a-10) Notwithstanding any other provision of this
19 Section, if for any fiscal year the General Assembly reduces
20 the guaranteed funding formula or the available appropriations
21 are insufficient to provide the amount required under that
22 funding formula, then in that same fiscal year all employee
23 contributions required under this Section shall be reduced by
24 the same percentage as the percentage by which the guaranteed
25 State funding or available appropriation was reduced below the

1 amount required under that funding formula as initially
2 certified by the System for that fiscal year.

3 If a court orders the State to pay full payment under the
4 guaranteed funding formula, or if a supplemental appropriation
5 sufficient to provide the amount required under that funding

20 in Section 30, in Sec. 15-157, by inserting after the end of
21 subsection (a-5) the following:

22 "(a-10) Notwithstanding any other provision of this
23 Section, if for any fiscal year the General Assembly reduces
24 the guaranteed funding formula or the available appropriations
25 are insufficient to provide the amount required under that

1 funding formula, then in that same fiscal year all employee
2 contributions required under this Section shall be reduced by
3 the same percentage as the percentage by which the guaranteed
4 State funding or available appropriation was reduced below the
5 amount required under that funding formula as initially
6 certified by the System for that fiscal year.

7 If a court orders the State to pay full payment under the
8 guaranteed funding formula, or if a supplemental appropriation
9 sufficient to provide the amount required under that funding
10 formula is enacted, then upon the first payment by the State at

24 in Section 30, in Sec. 16-152, by inserting after the end of
25 subsection (a-5) the following:

1 "(a-10) Notwithstanding any other provision of this
2 Section, if for any fiscal year the General Assembly reduces
3 the guaranteed funding formula or the available appropriations
4 are insufficient to provide the amount required under that
5 funding formula, then in that same fiscal year all employee
6 contributions required under this Section shall be reduced by
7 the same percentage as the percentage by which the guaranteed
8 State funding or available appropriation was reduced below the
9 amount required under that funding formula as initially
10 certified by the System for that fiscal year.

11 If a court orders the State to pay full payment under the
12 guaranteed funding formula, or if a supplemental appropriation
