- 2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend Senate Bill 2555, by deleting
- 3 everything after the enacting clause and replacing it with

- 9 Section 35. The sum of \$350,000, or so much thereof as
- 10 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
- 11 Fund to the Illinois State Board of Education for targeted
- 12 initiatives.
- 13 Section 40. The amount of \$550,000, or so much thereof as
- 14 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Downstate Transit
- 15 Improvement Fund to the Illinois State Board of Education for
- grants to Local Education Agencies to conduct Agriculture 16
- 17 Education Programs.
- 18 Section 45. If and only if House Bill 208 becomes law
- then Section 35 of Article 2 of that bill is amended as 19
- 20 follows:

1	"Section 35. The sum of \$27,400,000, or so much thereof
2	as may be necessary, is appropriated form the General Revenue
3	Fund to the Illinois State Board of Education for Student
4	Assessments, including Bilingual Assessments \div :
5	For writing assessments in
6	Grade 11\$2,530,000
7	For Student Assessments including
8	Bilingual Assessments\$24,870,000"
9	Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July ,
10	2013.".
