SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

520 ILCS 5/1.3a new

Amends the Wildlife Code. Provides that the Department of Natural Resources shall set a season during which white-tailed deer may be taken by use of firearms on the consecutive Saturday, Sunday, and Monday immediately before the fourth Thursday in November, commonly referred to as Thanksgiving Day.

3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Wildlife Code is amended by adding Section
5 1.3a as follows:

6 (520 ILCS 5/1.3a new)

7 Sec. 1.3a. Taking white-tailed deer. The Department shall
8 set a season during which white-tailed deer may be taken by use
9 of firearms on the consecutive Saturday, Sunday, and Monday
10 immediately before the fourth Thursday in November, commonly
11 referred to as Thanksgiving Day.
