

98TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2013 and 2014 SB3106

SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

50 ILCS 205/20 new 30 ILCS 805/8.38 new

Amends the Local Records Act. Provides that a unit of local government or a school district that maintains an Internet website shall maintain an electronic mail system. Requires that unit of local government or school district to maintain and provide an electronic mail address for each of its officials for use in the course of their official duties. Requires a unit of local government or school district to post to its website for the current calendar year the contact information, including an electronic mail address, for all elected and appointed officials. Limits home rule powers. Amends the State Mandates Act to require implementation without reimbursement.

- Section 5. The Local Records Act is amended by adding Section 20 as follows:
- 6 (50 ILCS 205/20 new)
- Sec. 20. Internet posting requirements.
- 8 (a) A unit of local government or a school district that
 9 maintains an Internet website shall, within 90 days of the
 10 effective date of this amendatory Act of the 98th General
 11 Assembly, do each of the following:
- 12 (1) maintain an electronic mail system;
- (2) maintain and provide an electronic mail address for

 each of its officials in the course of their official

 duties to be used exclusively for correspondence directly

 related to the official business of that unit of local

 government or school district; and
- (3) post to its website for the current calendar year
 the contact information, including an electronic mail
 address, for all elected and appointed officials.
- 21 <u>(b) The information required to be posted under this</u>
 22 <u>Section must be easily accessible from the unit of local</u>
 23 government's or school district's home page and searchable.

- 1 (c) The postings required by this Section are in addition
- 2 <u>to any other posting requirements required by law or ordinance.</u>
- 3 (d) No home rule unit may adopt posting requirements that
- 4 are less restrictive than this Section. This Section is a

- Sec. 8.38. Exempt mandate. Notwithstanding Sections 6 and 8
- of this Act, no reimbursement by the State is required for the
- implementation of any mandate created by this amendatory Act of
