SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

730 ILCS 125/11

Amends the County Jail Act. Provides that a minor who is transferred to adult jurisdiction may be confined in a county jail if he or she is properly classified and supervised to comply with the federal Prison Rape Elimination Act of 2003 as nearly as possible.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning criminal law.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The County Jail Act is amended by changing
5 Section 11 as follows:

6 (730 ILCS 125/11) (from Ch. 75, par. 111)

7 Sec. 11. Debtors and witnesses shall not be confined in the
8 same room with other prisoners; male and female prisoners shall
9 not be kept in the same room; minors shall be kept separate
10 from those previously convicted of a felony or other infamous
11 crime; and persons charged with an offense shall not be
12 confined in the same cell as those convicted of a crime. The
13 confinement of those persons convicted of a misdemeanor or
14 felony shall be in accordance with a classification system
15 developed and implemented by the local jail authority.

16 A minor who is transferred to adult jurisdiction may be
17 confined in a county jail if he or she is properly classified
18 and supervised to comply with the federal Prison Rape
19 Elimination Act of 2003 as nearly as possible.
