SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

15 ILCS 405/16.5 new

Amends the State Comptroller Act. Requires each State agency to, on the 30th day of each month, report to the Comptroller any delinquent obligations that are over 30 days received. Requires the Comptroller to, on the 15th day of the following month, report the number of delinquent obligations of State agencies in the aggregate for the previous month to the General Assembly. Defines "State agency". Effective immediately.

1 AN ACT concerning State government.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The State Comptroller Act is amended by adding
5 Section 16.5 as follows:

6 (15 ILCS 405/16.5 new)

7 Sec. 16.5. Monthly reports from State agencies; delinquent
8 bills.

9 (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, each State
10 agency shall, on the 30th day of each month, report to the
11 Comptroller any delinquent obligations that are over 30 days
12 received. The Comptroller shall by rule determine the format
13 and submission requirements for reports required under this
14 Section.

15 (b) On the 15th day of the following month, the Comptroller
16 shall report the number of delinquent obligations of State
17 agencies in the aggregate for the previous month to the General
18 Assembly.

19 (c) For the purposes of this Section, "State agencies"
20 means the Department of Aging, the Department of Corrections,
21 the Department of Agriculture, the Department of Human
22 Services, the Department of Central Management Services, the
23 Department of Children and Family Services, the Department of

1 Commerce and Economic Opportunity, the Department of Juvenile
2 Justice, the Department of Natural Resources, the Department of
3 Employment Security, the Department of Financial and
4 Professional Regulation, the Department of Insurance, the
5 Department of Labor, the Department of the Lottery, the
6 Department of Human Rights, the Department Military Affairs,
7 the Department of Natural Resources, the Department of Nuclear
8 Safety, the Department of Healthcare and Family Services, the
9 Department of Public Health, the Department of Revenue, the
10 Department of State Police, the Department of Transportation,
11 the Department of Veterans' Affairs, the Department of the
12 State Fire Marshal, the Governor's Office of Management and
13 Budget, the Capital Development Board, the Emergency
14 Management Agency, the Historic Preservation Agency, the
15 Illinois Finance Authority, the Illinois Housing Development
16 Authority, the Illinois Investment and Development Authority,
17 the Illinois Power Agency, and the Illinois Health Information
18 Exchange Authority.

19 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
20 becoming law.
