

98TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2013 and 2014 SB3669

SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

105 ILCS 5/10-20.56 new 105 ILCS 5/34-18.49 new

Amends the School Code. Provides that a school board shall require that each school building in the district be equipped with approved carbon monoxide alarms in accordance with the rules of the State Fire Marshal. Provides that the State Fire Marshal shall, by rule, (i) determine the number of alarms a public school building must have and where those alarms must be located, (ii) require that the alarms be in operating condition and be inspected annually, and (iii) exempt school buildings from the alarm requirement if they do not have or are not close to any sources of carbon monoxide. Effective immediately.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The School Code is amended by adding Sections 10-20.56 and 34-18.49 as follows:
