SENATE RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, The members of the Illinois Senate are deeply 3 saddened to learn of the death of Daniel Joseph Edelman of 4 Chicago; and

WHEREAS, Daniel Edelman was born in Manhattan in New York City on July 3, 1920, to Selig and Selma Edelman; he graduated from DeWitt Clinton High School in the Bronx and from Columbia University in 1940; he spent time as a sports reporter and served in the U.S. Army during World War II; after the war, he was a night reporter for CBS in New York and worked as a publicist for Musicraft Records; he married Ruth Ann Rozumoff; and

WHEREAS, By 1947, Daniel Edelman was living in Chicago; he was the founder and chairman of one of the largest public relations firms in the world and a groundbreaker in the field; he began his company in a small office in Chicago in 1952 and it has grown to include 63 offices in 26 countries, with more than 4,600 employees; and

WHEREAS, His company has helped build such well-known brands as Sara Lee, KFC, Microsoft, Pfizer, General Electric, Wal-Mart Stores, Abbott Laboratories, Samsung, Royal Dutch Shell, Kraft, Johnson & Johnson, and Unilever; and
