WHEREAS, Robert Krockey practiced law in Joliet from 1967 to 2014; he was senior partner of the law firm Krockey, Cernugel, Cowgill, and Clark; he also served on numerous bar association committees; and

WHEREAS, Robert Krockey was a board member and President of the Will County Legal Assistance Program for many years, devoting many hours of legal aid for the poor; he served as President of the Will County Sheltered Workshop and United Cerebral Palsy, where he was recipient of the Mel Larson Award;
