The Counties Code is amended by changing 4 Sections 5-44010 and 5-44020 and by adding Section 5-44060 as 5 6 follows: 7 (55 ILCS 5/5-44010) Sec. 5-44010. Applicability. The powers and authorities 8 provided by this Division 5-44 apply to McHenry County, Lake 9 County, and DuPage County only to counties with a population of 10 11 more than 900,000 and less than 3,000,000 that are contiquous to a county with a population of more than 3,000,000 and units 12 13 of local government within such counties. - Sec. 5-44020. Definitions. In this Division 5-44: 1
- "Fire protection jurisdiction" means a fire protection 2
- district, municipal fire department, or service organized 3
- 4 under Section 5-1056.1 of the Counties Code, Sections 195 and
- 5 200 of the Township Code, Section 10-2.1 of the Illinois
- 6 Municipal Code, or the Illinois Fire Protection District Act.
- "Governing board" means the individual or individuals who 7
- constitute the corporate authorities of a unit of local 8
- 9 government.
- 10 "Unit of local government" or "unit" means any unit of
- 11 local government located entirely within one county, to which
- the county board chairman or county executive directly appoints 12
- 13 a majority of its governing board with the advice and consent
- 14 of the county board, but shall not include a fire protection
- 15 district that directly employs any regular full-time
- 16 employees, a conservation district organized under the
- Conservation District Act, or a special district organized 17
- under the Water Commission Act of 1985. 18

- 21 Sec. 5-44060. Rights of former employees. On the effective
- 22 date of dissolution, the employees of the former unit of local
- 23 government shall be transferred to the governmental unit
- 24 assuming the functions of the former unit of local government.
- The status and rights of employees represented by an exclusive 25

- 1 bargaining representative shall not be affected by the 2 consolidation or this amendatory Act of the 99th General 3 Assembly. Obligations assumed by the government unit assuming 4 the functions of the former governmental unit shall include the 5 obligation to honor existing representation rights under the Illinois Public Labor Relations Act and any existing collective 6 bargaining agreements. The rights of employees under any 7 existing pension, retirement, or annuity plan shall not be 8 9 affected by the consolidation or this amendatory Act of the 10 99th General Assembly.
- 11 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon 12 becoming law.".
