The Illinois Municipal Code is amended by 4 adding Section 8-1-2.10 as follows: 5 6 (65 ILCS 5/8-1-2.10 new)7 Sec. 8-1-2.10. Use of municipal funds for advertisements. No advertisement may be purchased using municipal funds that 8 would include the name of any person holding an elected office. 9 10 For purposes of this Section, "advertisement" means any type of 11 announcement that is purchased for promotional purposes for 12 print in a book, publication, brochure, sign, or digital media. "Advertisement" does not include a community newsletter 13 providing information pertaining to the community that is 14 distributed to all residents and businesses within the 15

community, brochures or similar informational materials that

1	announce or describe community events or activities such as
2	conservation or recreational programs or festivals or other
3	similar events. In addition, "advertisement" does not include a
4	welcome sign posted upon entering a community or a sign located
5	at a governmental facility.
6	A violation of this Section shall result in the violator
7	repaying the municipal funds used for the advertisement plus
8	\$100. A second violation of this Section will result in the

9 violator repaying the municipal funds used for the 10 advertisement plus \$250. A third and any subsequent violations of this Section will result in the violator repaying the 11

municipal funds used for the advertisement plus \$500.". 12
