## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

55 ILCS 5/3-4007 from Ch. 34, par. 3-4007

Amends the Counties Code. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning the compensation to be paid to the Public Defender.

AN ACT concerning local government.

# Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly: 

Section 5. The Counties Code is amended by changing Section $3-4007$ as follows:
(55 ILCS 5/3-4007) (from Ch. 34, par. 3-4007)
Sec. 3-4007. Compensation.
(a) The the public defender shall be paid out of the county treasury, and, subject to appropriation, shall be paid by the Department of Revenue out of the Personal Property Tax Replacement Fund or the General Revenue Fund as provided in subsection (b), as the sole compensation for his or her services a salary in an amount fixed by the County Board. When a Public Defender in a county of 30,000 or more population is receiving not less than $90 \%$ of the compensation of the State's Attorney of such county, that Public Defender shall not engage in the private practice of law.
(b) The State must pay $662 / 3 \%$ of the public defender's annual salary. If the public defender is employed full-time in that capacity, his or her salary must be at least $90 \%$ of that county's State's attorney's annual compensation. Subject to appropriation, these amounts furnished by the State shall be payable monthly by the Department of Revenue out of the

Personal Property Tax Replacement Fund or the General Revenue Fund to the county in which each Public Defender is employed.
(c) In cases where 2 or more adjoining counties have joined to form a common office of Public Defender, the salary of the Public Defender shall be set and paid as provided by a joint resolution of the various county boards involved.
