1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 805

2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend House Bill 805 by replacing  
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. If and only if Senate Bill 1 of the 99th  
5 General Assembly becomes law, the School Code is amended by  
6 adding Section 18-8.20 as follows:

7 (105 ILCS 5/18-8.20 new)

8 Sec. 18-8.20. Supplementary grants in aid.

9 (a) Notwithstanding any other provision in Section 18-8.15  
10 of this Code, the amount of State aid under Section 18-8.15 for  
11 which each school district is eligible shall be no less than  
12 the amount of the State aid entitlement that was received by  
13 the district under Section 18-8.05 of this Code for the  
14 2014-2015 school year, pursuant to the provisions of Section  
15 18-8.05 as it was then in effect. If a school district  
16 qualifies to receive a supplementary payment made under this

1 Section, the amount of State aid under Section 18-8.15 of this  
2 Code that the district is eligible to receive for each school  
3 year shall be no less than the amount of the State aid  
4 entitlement that was received by the district under Section  
5 18-8.05 of this Code for the 2014-2015 school year, pursuant to  
6 the provisions of Section 18-8.05 as it was then in effect.

7 (b) If, as provided in subsection (a) of this Section, a  
8 school district is to receive State aid under Section 18-8.15  
9 of this Code for the 2015-2016 school year and any subsequent  
10 school year that in any such school year is less than the  
11 amount of the State aid entitlement that the district received  
12 for the 2014-2015 school year, the school district shall also  
13 receive, from a separate appropriation made for the purposes of  
14 this Section, a supplementary payment that is equal to the  
15 amount of the difference in the State aid figures as described  
16 in subsection (a) of this Section.

17 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon  
18 becoming law or on the date Senate Bill 1 of the 99th General  
19 Assembly takes effect, whichever is later."
