2	AMENDMENT NO Amend House Bill 865 by replacing
3	everything after the enacting clause with the following:
4	"Section 5. The MC/DD Act is amended by adding Section
5	3-305.5 as follows:

7	Sec. 3-305.5. Violation of the Nurse Practice Act. A
8	facility that fails to submit any required report under Section
9	85-10 of the Nurse Practice Act is subject to discipline under
10	this Article.
11	Section 10. The Nurse Practice Act is amended by adding
12	Article 85 as follows:

14	ARTICLE 85. BASIC SUCTIONING AIDE PILOT PROGRAM

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1	(225 ILCS 65/85-5 new)
2	Sec. 85-5. Definitions. For the purposes of this Article
3	<u>only:</u>
4	"Basic suctioning" means the process of using oral
5	suctioning of the upper airway to remove foreign matter, such
6	as mucus, fluids, or blood, which may involve the use of a
7	Yankauer suction catheter.
8	"Basic suctioning aide" means a person who has met the
9	qualifications for licensure under this Article who assists
10	with basic suctioning administration while under the
11	supervision of a registered professional nurse (RN) in a
12	facility licensed under the MC/DD Act.
13	"Qualified employer" means a facility in good standing
14	under the MC/DD Act.
15	(225 ILCS 65/85-10 new)
16	<u>Sec. 85-10. Pilot program.</u>
17	(a) The Department shall administer and enforce a Licensed
18	Basic Suctioning Aide Pilot Program. The program shall last for
19	a period of 3 years, as determined by rule. During the 3-year
20	pilot program, the Department shall license and regulate
21	licensed basic suctioning aides. The Department may consult
22	with the Department of Public Health as necessary to properly
23	administer and enforce this Article.
24	(b) To be approved as a gualified facility for the duration

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1	of the pilot program, a facility must:
2	(1) be a licensed facility in good standing under the
3	MC/DD Act;
4	(2) certify that the employment of a licensed basic
5	suctioning aide will not replace or diminish the employment
6	of a registered nurse or licensed practical nurse at the
7	<u>facility;</u>
8	(3) certify that a registered nurse will be on-duty and
9	present in the facility to delegate and supervise the basic
10	suctioning administration by a licensed basic suctioning
11	aide at all times;
12	(4) certify that, with the exception of licensed health
13	care professionals, only licensed basic suctioning aides
14	will be employed in the capacity of administering basic
15	suctioning; and
16	(5) provide information regarding patient safety,
17	efficiency, and errors as determined by the Department;
18	failure to submit any required report may be grounds for
19	discipline or sanctions under this Act or the MC/DD Act.
20	The Department shall submit a report regarding patient
21	safety, efficiency, and errors, as determined by rule, to the
22	General Assembly no later than 6 months after termination of
23	the pilot program.

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1	Sec. 85-20. Scope of practice.
2	(a) A licensed basic suctioning aide may only practice in a
3	qualified facility.
4	(b) Licensed basic suctioning aides must be supervised by
5	and receive delegation by a registered nurse that is on-duty
6	and present in the facility at all times.
7	(225 ILCS 65/85-25 new)
8	Sec. 85-25. Unlicensed practice; violation; civil penalty.
9	(a) In addition to any other penalty provided by law, any
10	person who practices, offers to practice, attempts to practice,
11	or holds oneself out to practice as a basic suctioning aide
12	without being licensed under this Act shall, in addition to any
13	other penalty provided by law, pay a civil penalty to the
14	Department in an amount not to exceed \$10,000 for each offense
15	as determined by the Department. The civil penalty shall be
16	assessed by the Department after a hearing is held in
17	accordance with the provisions set forth in this Act regarding
18	the provision of a hearing for the discipline of a licensee.
19	(b) The Department has the authority and power to
20	investigate any and all unlicensed activity.
21	(c) The civil penalty shall be paid within 60 days after
22	the effective date of the order imposing the civil penalty. The
23	order shall constitute a judgment and may be filed and
24	execution had thereon in the same manner as any judgment from
25	any court of record.

2 Sec. 85-30. Applications for original licensure. 3 Applications for original licensure shall be made to the 4 Department in writing on forms prescribed by the Department and 5 shall be accompanied by the required fee, which shall not be 6 returnable. The application shall require such information as, in the judgment of the Department, will enable the Department 7 8 to pass on the qualifications of the applicant for licensure. 9 Applicants have 3 years after the date of application to complete the application process. If the process has not been 10 completed within 3 years, the application shall be denied, the 11 12 fee forfeited, and the applicant must reapply and meet the 13 requirements in effect at the time of reapplication.

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(225 ILCS 65/85-35 new)

15 Sec. 85-35. Examinations. The Department shall authorize 16 examinations of applicants for a license under this Article at 17 the times and place as it may designate. The examination shall 18 be of a character to give a fair test of the qualifications of 19 the applicant to practice as a basic suctioning aide.

Applicants for examination as a basic suctioning aide shall be required to pay, either to the Department or the designated testing service, a fee covering the cost of providing the examination. Failure to appear for the examination on the scheduled date, at the time and place specified, after the 09900HB0865ham002 -7- LRB099 04689 SMS 47130 a

applicant's application for examination has been received and 1 acknowledged by the Department or the designated testing 2 3 service, shall result in the forfeiture of the examination fee. 4 If an applicant fails to pass an examination for 5 registration under this Act within 3 years after filing his or her application, the application shall be denied. The applicant 6 may thereafter make a <u>new application accompanied by the</u> 7 required fee; however, the app<u>licant shall meet all</u> 8 9 requirements in effect at the time of subsequent application 10 before obtaining licensure. The Department may employ 11 consultants for the purposes of preparing and conducting 12 examinations. 13 (225 ILCS 65/85-40 new) 14 Sec. 85-40. Licensure by examination. An applicant for

licensure by examination to practice as a licensed basic 15 suctioning aide must: 16 (1) submit a completed written application on forms 17 18 provided by the Department and fees as established by the 19 Department; 20 (2) be age 18 or older; 21 (3) have a high school diploma or a certificate of 22 general education development (GED); 23 (4) demonstrate the ability to speak, read, and write 24 the English language, as determined by rule;

25 <u>(5) be currently certified in good standing as a</u>

1	certified nursing assistant;
2	(6) submit to the criminal history records check
3	required under Section 50-35 of this Act;
4	(7) have not engaged in conduct or behavior determined
5	to be grounds for discipline under this Act;
6	(8) be currently certified to perform cardiopulmonary
7	resuscitation by the American Heart Association or
8	American Red Cross;
9	(9) have successfully completed a course of study
10	approved by the Department as defined by rule; to be
11	approved, the program must include a minimum of 8 hours of
12	classroom-based suctioning aide education and a minimum of
13	5 hours of registered nurse-supervised clinical practicum
14	with progressive responsibility of patient suctioning
15	assistance; such course of study and training may be
16	developed by the qualified facility staff with approval by
17	the Department;
18	(10) have successfully completed the Basic Suctioning
19	Aide Certification Examination or other examination
20	authorized by the Department; and
21	(11) submit proof of employment by a qualifying
22	facility.
23	(225 ILCS 65/85-45 new)
24	Sec. 85-45. Expiration of license. The expiration date for

25 <u>each license to practice as a licensed basic suctioning aide</u>

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1	shall be set by the rule. Licenses under this Article may not
2	be renewed or restored.
3	(225 ILCS 65/85-50 new)
4	Sec. 85-50. Administration and enforcement. Licenses
5	issued under this Article are subject to Article 70, including
6	grounds for disciplinary action under Section 70-5 of this Act.
7	(225 ILCS 65/85-55 new)
8	Sec. 85-55. Title. Any person who is issued a license as a
9	basic suctioning aide under the terms of this Act shall use the
10	words "licensed basic suctioning aide" in connection with his
11	or her name to denote his or her licensure under this Act.
12	(225 ILCS 65/85-60 new)
13	Sec. 85-60. Rules. The Department shall file rules to
14	administer this Article within 90 days after the effective date
15	of this amendatory Act of the 99th General Assembly.
16	Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
17	becoming law.".
