Amends the One Day Rest In Seven Act. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning meal periods.

1 AN ACT concerning employment.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The One Day Rest In Seven Act is amended by changing Section 3 as follows:
- 6 (820 ILCS 140/3) (from Ch. 48, par. 8c)
- Sec. 3. Every employer shall permit its employees who are to work for 7 1/2 continuous hours or longer, except those
- 9 specified in this Section, at least 20 minutes for a meal
- 10 period beginning no later than 5 hours after $\underline{\text{the}}$ start of
- 11 the work period.
- 12 This Section does not apply to employees for whom meal
- periods are established through the collective bargaining
- 14 process.
- This Section does not apply to employees who monitor
- 16 individuals with developmental disabilities or mental illness,
- or both, and who, in the course of those duties, are required
- 18 to be on call during an entire 8 hour work period; however,
- those employees shall be allowed to eat a meal during the 8
- 20 hour work period while continuing to monitor those individuals.
