2	AMENDMENT NO Amend House Bill 1321 by replacing
3	everything after the enacting clause with the following:
4	"Section 1. Short title. This Act may be cited as the
5	Career and Workforce Transition Act.
6	Section 5. Definitions.
7	"Board" means the Board of Higher Education.
8	"Institution" means a non-degree granting institution tha
9	is regulated and approved by the Board under the Private
10	Business and Vocational Schools Act of 2012 and that is
11	nationally certified by an accreditor approved by the U.S
12	Department of Education.

Section 10. Transfer of credits. A public community college

district shall accept up to 30 credit hours transferred from an

institution that has been approved under Section 15 of this Act

- 1 if a student has completed one of the following programs at
- that institution: 2
- 3 (1) Medical Assisting.
- (2) Medical Coding. 4
- 5 (3) Dental Assisting.
- (4) HVAC (Heating, Ventilation, and Air Conditioning). 6
- 7 (5) Welding.
- 8 (6) Pharmacy Technician.
- 9 The program must, at a minimum, be a 9-month program and use a
- 10 credit-hour system.
- 11 Section 15. Board approval. The Board may approve an
- institution as an institution from which credits may be 12
- transferred under Section 10 of this Act if all of 13
- 14 following conditions are met:
- 15 institution has submitted all (1)The proper
- 16 documentation that the Board requests.
- 17 (2) The institution has paid a fee to the Board, in an
- 18 amount as determined by Board rule.
- 19 (3) The institution has successfully completed a full
- term of national accreditation without probation, 2.0
- 21 warning, or the denial of a substantive change in an
- 22 without being denied accreditation, application,
- 23 without withdrawing an application and has completed all of
- 24 the necessary requirements to be approved by the Board
- under the Private Business and Vocational Schools Act of 25

1 2012.

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- (4) The Board has verified the institution's good standing during the period of its national accreditation. Credit transfers from the institution may be made only during the verified accreditation period. An institution that is under review due to probation, a warning, or the denial of a substantive change in an application, that is denied accreditation, or that withdraws an application for national accreditation may not be approved under this Section.
- Section 90. Rulemaking. The Board shall adopt any rules necessary to carry out its responsibilities under this Act.".
