1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 1359 2 AMENDMENT NO. . Amend House Bill 1359, AS AMENDED, by 3 replacing everything after the enacting clause with the 4 following: "Section 5. The Department of Professional Regulation Law 5 6 of the Civil Administrative Code of Illinois is amended by 7 adding Section 2105-170 as follows: (20 ILCS 2105/2105-170 new) 8 9 Sec. 2105-170. Health care workers; automatic suspension 10 of license. A health care worker, as defined by the Health Care 11 Worker Self-Referral Act, licensed by the Department shall be automatically and indefinitely suspended at such time as the 12 final trial proceedings are concluded whereby a licensee has 13 been either convicted of, or has entered a plea of guilty or 14 15 nolo contendere in a criminal prosecution to, a criminal health

care or criminal insurance fraud offense, requiring intent,

under the laws of the State, the laws of any other state, or 1 the laws of the United States of America, including, but not 2 3 limited to, criminal Medicare or Medicaid fraud. A certified 4 copy of the conviction or judgment shall be the basis for the 5 suspension. If a licensee requests a hearing, then the sole purpose of the hearing shall be limited to the length of the 6 suspension of the licensee's license, as the conviction or 7 judgment is a matter of record and may not be challenged.".
