Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Hospital Licensing Act is amended by changing Section 11.7 as follows:
- 6 (210 ILCS 85/11.7)
- 7 Sec. 11.7. Sudden Infant Death Syndrome (SIDS) Education.
- 8 (a) A hospital shall provide, free of charge, information
- 9 and instructional materials regarding sudden infant death
- 10 syndrome (SIDS), explaining the medical effects upon infants
- and young children and emphasizing measures that may reduce the
- 12 risk. The materials shall include information concerning safe
- 13 sleep environments developed by the American Academy of
- 14 Pediatrics or a statewide or nationally recognized SIDS or
- 15 medical association.
- 16 (b) The information and materials described in subsection
- 17 (a) shall be provided to parents or legal quardians of each
- newborn, upon discharge from the hospital. Prior to discharge,
- a nurse or appropriate staff person shall review the proffered
- 20 materials with the infant's parents or legal guardian and shall
- 21 discuss best practices to reduce the incidence of SIDS as
- 22 recommended by the American Academy of Pediatrics.
- 23 (c) Nothing in this Section prohibits a hospital from

- obtaining free and suitable information from a public or 1
- 2 private agency.
