9	by each legislative leader. Members	s of the Commission shall
10	receive no compensation, but may	be reimbursed for their

12	Chairperson of the Chicago State Un	iversity Board of Trustees
13	or his or her designee shall be	the chairperson of the

1 disability, or resignation of any member appointed by that 2 leader.

3 Section 10. Administrative support. Chicago State 4 University shall provide administrative support to the 5 Commission.

6 Section 15. Commission duties.

7 (a) The Commission shall identify issues concerning the 8 readiness and ability of young adults to find employment after 9 graduating from college or otherwise completing their education that may be addressed by the 99th General Assembly 10 and future General Assemblies. The Commission shall make 11 recommendations regarding the issues identified. The issues 12 13 and recommendations shall address the barriers faced by young 14 adults who seek employment or promotional opportunities in State government and possible incentives that could be offered 15 16 to foster the employment of and the promotion of young adults 17 in State government.

(b) The Commission shall consult with State agencies,
community stakeholders, other universities and institutions of
higher education, and local school boards.

Section 20. Findings and recommendations. The Commission shall meet and begin its work no later than 60 days after the appointment of all Commission members. By November 30, 2015, 09900HB1490ham002 -3- LRB099 05926 HEP 32655 a

and by November 30 of every year thereafter, the Commission 1 2 shall submit a report to the General Assembly setting forth its 3 findings and recommendations. The requirement for reporting to 4 the General Assembly shall be satisfied by filing copies of the 5 report with the Speaker, Minority Leader, and Clerk of the House of Representatives, the President, Minority Leader, and 6 7 Secretary of the Senate, and the Legislative Research Unit as required under Section 3.1 of the General Assembly Organization 8 9 Act.

10 Section 97. Repeal. This Act is repealed January 1, 2019.

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon becoming law.".
