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#### Abstract

Amends the School Code. Provides that a school board shall require its schools to either connect at-risk students with anger management classes offered in the community or conduct their own anger management classes for at-risk students. Provides that if the school board requires a school to conduct these classes, the classes do not have to be implemented until the beginning of the 2017-2018 school year. Effective immediately.

# Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly: 

Section 5. The School Code is amended by adding Sections 10-20.56 and 34-18.49 as follows:

(105 ILCS 5/10-20.56 new)
Sec. 10-20.56. Anger management classes. A school board
shall require its schools to either connect at-risk students
with anger management classes offered in the community or
conduct their own anger management classes for at-risk
students. If the school board requires a school to conduct
these classes, the classes do not have to be implemented until
the beginning of the $2017-2018$ school year.
(105 ILCS 5/34-18.49 new)

Sec. 34-18.49. Anger management classes. The board shall require its schools to either connect at-risk students with anger management classes offered in the community or conduct their own anger management classes for at-risk students. If the board requires a school to conduct these classes, the classes do not have to be implemented until the beginning of the 2017-2018 school year.

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon 2 becoming law.
