#### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

305 ILCS 5/12-4.4a new

Amends the Illinois Public Aid Code. Provides that on and after January 1, 2016, electronic benefits transfer ("LINK") cards used to obtain Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) benefits or cash shall contain the name and photo of the primary cardholder and, at the option of the primary cardholder, the names of secondary holders who are authorized to use the card. Establishes that an individual may only use the LINK card if the photo on the card matches the user or he or she presents a current and valid photo identification that confirms that he or she is a secondary user listed on the card. Provides that on the effective date of the amendatory Act the Department of Human Services shall begin the process of transitioning to the use of LINK cards which contain the name and photo of the primary cardholder and list the names of all authorized users of the card. Requires the transition to be completed no later than January 1, 2016. Effective immediately.

1 AN ACT concerning public aid.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**  
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Illinois Public Aid Code is amended by  
5 adding Section 12-4.4a as follows:

6 (305 ILCS 5/12-4.4a new)

7 Sec. 12-4.4a. Electronic benefits transfer card; SNAP  
8 benefits.

9 (a) In this Section, "LINK card" means an electronic  
10 benefits transfer card issued by the Department of Human  
11 Services for the purpose of enabling a user of the card to  
12 obtain Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)  
13 benefits or cash.

14 (b) On and after January 1, 2016, LINK cards used to obtain  
15 Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) benefits or  
16 cash shall contain the name and photo of the primary  
17 cardholder. In addition, the card shall contain, at the option  
18 of the primary cardholder, the names of secondary cardholders  
19 who are authorized to use the card to obtain SNAP benefits or  
20 cash. An individual may use the LINK card to obtain SNAP  
21 benefits or cash only if:

22 (1) he or she is the primary cardholder listed on the  
23 card and the photo on the card matches the user; or

1           (2) he or she is the secondary cardholder listed on the  
2           card and he or she shows a current and valid photo  
3           identification that confirms that he or she is a secondary  
4           user listed on the card.

5           (c) On the effective date of this amendatory Act of the  
6           99th General Assembly, the Department of Human Services shall  
7           begin the process of transitioning to the use of LINK cards  
8           which contain the name and photo of the primary cardholder and  
9           list the names of all authorized users of the card. This  
10           transition shall be completed no later than January 1, 2016.

11           Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon  
12           becoming law.
