### HB2502

Introduced 2/18/2015, by Rep. Daniel J. Burke

#### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

40 ILCS 5/17-133.5 new  
30 ILCS 805/8.39 new

Amends the Chicago Teacher Article of the Illinois Pension Code. Provides that any earned sick pay which is payable by an employer shall be considered pensionable earnings as provided by Section 17-134 and the charter school shall certify the number of sick days being paid. Also provides that any sum paid by a charter school employer before or after the school year shall be considered pensionable earnings if the payment is conditioned in any way on service being performed by the contributor. Amends the State Mandates Act to require implementation without reimbursement. Effective immediately.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**  
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Illinois Pension Code is amended by adding  
5 Section 17-133.5 as follows:

6 (40 ILCS 5/17-133.5 new)

7 Sec. 17-133.5. Pensionable earnings; charter school  
8 reporting. Any earned sick pay which is payable by an employer  
9 shall be considered pensionable earnings as provided by Section  
10 17-134 and the charter school shall certify the number of sick  
11 days being paid. Any sum paid by a charter school employer  
12 before or after the school year shall be considered pensionable  
13 earnings if the payment is conditioned in any way on service  
14 being performed by the contributor.

15 Section 90. The State Mandates Act is amended by adding  
16 Section 8.39 as follows:

17 (30 ILCS 805/8.39 new)

18 Sec. 8.39. Exempt mandate. Notwithstanding Sections 6 and 8  
19 of this Act, no reimbursement by the State is required for the  
20 implementation of any mandate created by this amendatory Act of  
21 the 99th General Assembly.

1           Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon  
2    becoming law.
