

1 AN ACT concerning transportation.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by changing
5 Section 3-806.3 as follows:

6 (625 ILCS 5/3-806.3) (from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 3-806.3)

7 Sec. 3-806.3. Senior Citizens. Commencing with the 2009
8 registration year, the registration fee paid by any vehicle
9 owner who has been approved for benefits under the Senior
10 Citizens and Disabled Persons Property Tax Relief Act or who is
11 the spouse of such a person shall be \$24 instead of the fee
12 otherwise provided in this Code for passenger cars displaying
13 standard multi-year registration plates issued under Section
14 3-414.1, motor vehicles displaying special registration plates
15 issued under Section 3-609, 3-616, 3-621, 3-622, 3-623, 3-624,
16 3-625, 3-626, 3-628, 3-638, 3-642, 3-645, 3-647, 3-650, 3-651,
17 or 3-663, motor vehicles registered at 8,000 pounds or less
18 under Section 3-815(a), and recreational vehicles registered
19 at 8,000 pounds or less under Section 3-815(b). Widows and
20 widowers of claimants shall also be entitled to this reduced
21 registration fee for the registration year in which the
22 claimant was eligible.

23 Commencing with the 2009 registration year, the

1 registration fee paid by any vehicle owner who has claimed and
2 received a grant under the Senior Citizens and Disabled Persons
3 Property Tax Relief Act or who is the spouse of such a person
4 shall be \$24 instead of the fee otherwise provided in this Code
5 for passenger cars displaying standard multi-year registration
6 plates issued under Section 3-414.1, motor vehicles displaying
7 special registration plates issued under Section 3-607, 3-609,
8 3-616, 3-621, 3-622, 3-623, 3-624, 3-625, 3-626, 3-628, 3-638,
9 3-642, 3-645, 3-647, 3-650, 3-651, 3-663, or 3-664, motor
10 vehicles registered at 8,000 pounds or less under Section
11 3-815(a), and recreational vehicles registered at 8,000 pounds
12 or less under Section 3-815(b). Widows and widowers of
13 claimants shall also be entitled to this reduced registration
14 fee for the registration year in which the claimant was
15 eligible.

16 Commencing with the 2017 registration year, the reduced fee
17 under this Section shall apply to any special registration
18 plate authorized in Article VI of Chapter 3 of this Code, for
19 which the applicant would otherwise be eligible.

20 No more than one reduced registration fee under this
21 Section shall be allowed during any 12 month period based on
22 the primary eligibility of any individual, whether such reduced
23 registration fee is allowed to the individual or to the spouse,
24 widow or widower of such individual. This Section does not
25 apply to the fee paid in addition to the registration fee for
26 motor vehicles displaying vanity, personalized, or special

1 license plates.
