1 AN ACT concerning State government.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Illinois Emergency Management Agency Act is amended by changing Section 17.5 as follows:

6 (20 ILCS 3305/17.5)

Sec. 17.5. Homeland Security Emergency Preparedness Fund. The Homeland Security Emergency Preparedness <u>Trust</u> Fund is created as a <u>federal trust fund</u> special fund in the State treasury. The <u>Trust</u> Fund shall be held separate and apart from all public moneys or funds of this State. All <u>Homeland Security</u> moneys received by the Agency under Section 17 from a federal department or agency shall be deposited into the <u>Trust</u> Fund. Interest earned by the investment or deposit of moneys accumulated in the <u>Trust</u> Fund shall be deposited into the <u>Trust</u> Fund. The Agency is authorized to expend any moneys in the <u>Trust</u> Fund for the specific purposes established by the terms and conditions of the federal awards received by the Agency and in any amount that the Agency deems necessary to make grants and pay expenses in connection with its emergency management and preparedness programs.
