# Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

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1 Section 5. In addition to other amounts appropriated, 2 the amount of \$19,184,400, or so much thereof as may be 3 necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to 4 the Department of Agriculture for operational expenses, 5 awards, grants and permanent improvements for the fiscal year 6 ending June 30, 2016.
