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      (f) Commodities;
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      (g) Printing;
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      (h) Equipment;
      (i) Electronic data processing;
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      (j) Telecommunications services;
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      (k) Operation of automotive equipment;
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      (1) Refunds;
      (m) Employee retirement contributions paid by the employer;
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      (n) Permanent improvements;
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1	Section 5. In addition to other amounts appropriated,
2	the amount of \$44,935,900, or so much thereof as may be
3	necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to
4	the Department of Central Management Services for operational
5	expenses, awards, grants and permanent improvements for the
6	fiscal year ending June 30, 2016.

Section 10. The amount of \$30,000, or so much thereof as 7 8 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue 9 Fund to the Department of Central Management Services for 10 awards and grants to employees and expenses of the Employee 11 Suggestion Board.
