Makes appropriations for the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Department of Insurance for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2015, as follows:

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 1. The following named amounts, or so much
6 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects
7 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated from the
8 Insurance Producer Administration Fund to the Department of
9 Insurance:

4 Section 5. The sum of \$700,000, or so much thereof as
5 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Insurance Producer
6 Administration Fund to the Department of Insurance for costs
7 and expenses related to or in support of a Regulatory/G&A
8 Shared Services Center.

9 Section 10. The sum of \$1,000,000, or so much thereof as
10 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Insurance Producer
11 Administration Fund to the Department of Insurance for costs
12 and expenses related to or in support of Get Covered
13 Illinois.

14 Section 15. The sum of \$750,000, or so much thereof as
15 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Insurance Producer
16 Administration Fund to the Department of Insurance for costs
17 and expenses related to or in support of the agency's
18 operations.

19 Section 20. The following named amounts, or so much
20 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects
21 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated from the

 21 Financial Regulation Fund to the Department of Insurance for
 22 costs and expenses related to or in support of the agency's
 23 operations.

 2 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects
 3 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated from the
 4 Public Pension Regulation Fund to the Department of
 5 Insurance:

19 Section 35. The sum of \$950,000, or so much thereof as
 20 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Workers'
 21 Compensation Commission Operations Fund to the Department of
 22 Insurance for costs associated with the administration and
 23 operations of the Insurance Fraud Division of the Illinois
 24 Workers' Compensation Commission's anti-fraud program.

1 Section 40. The sum of \$500,000, or so much thereof as
2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Public Pension
3 Regulation Fund to the Department of Insurance for costs and
4 expenses related to or in support of the agency's operations.

5 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
6 2015.
