- 2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 2990, by deleting
- 3 everything after the enacting clause and inserting the
- 4 following:
- 5 "ARTICLE 1
- 6 Section 5. The sum of \$5,482,188,200, is appropriated
- 7 from the General Revenue Fund to the Illinois State Board of
- 8 Education for payments to entities eligible for General State
- 9 Aid as provided in the following amounts and the following
- order of priority: (i) an amount equal to the total amount
- 11 appropriated for General State Aid for the 2015-2016 school
- 12 year shall be paid to eligible entities in accordance with
- 13 the provisions of Section 18-8.05 of the School Code as in
- 14 effect for the 2015-2016 school year plus, when applicable,

1 the amounts paid from the appropriation contained in Section 10 of Article 1 of Public Act 99-5 in accordance with the 2 provisions of that Section as in effect for the 2015-2016 3 school year; (ii) an Equity Grant, which shall be an amount 4 equal to the product of the entity's Low Income Concentration 5 6 Level and the Low Income Constant minus the product of the entity's Available Local Resources per pupil and seven 7 percent, all multiplied by the low income eligible pupil 8 9 count as used in Section 18-8.05 of the School Code and where 10 the Low Income Constant means a constant value for all Equity 11 Grant calculations in order to distribute an Equity Grant of \$700,000,000 in accordance with the preceding formula while 12 13 ensuring that any entity for which the grant calculation is less than zero will receive no funds from the Equity Grant; 14 (iii) an amount necessary to ensure all eligible entities 15 16 receive no less than their General State Aid claim for the 17 2016-2017 school year, after the amounts paid under items (i) 18 and (ii) of this Section; and (iv) any remaining amounts 19 shall be provided to fund General State Aid payments 20 calculated in accordance with the provisions of Section 18-21 8.05 of the School Code, but only after subtracting the 22 amounts provided to eligible entities pursuant to items (i), 23 (ii), and (iii) of this Section
