8	(a) Instead of furnishing a co	opy of the trust instrument to
9	a person other than the beneficia:	ry, the trustee may furnish to
10	the person a certification of the	rust containing the following
11	information:	
12	(1) a statement that the	trust exists and the date the
13	trust instrument was executed	<u>;</u>
14	(2) the identity of the se	ettlor;
15	(3) the identity and add	ress of the currently acting
16	trustee;	

Τ	(4) the powers of the trustee;
2	(5) the revocability or irrevocability of the trust,
3	whether the trust is amendable or unamendable, and the
4	identity of any person holding a power to revoke or amend
5	the trust;
6	(6) the authority of co-trustees to sign or otherwise
7	authenticate and whether all or less than all are required
8	in order to exercise powers of the trustee;
9	(7) the trust's taxpayer identification number; and
10	(8) the manner of taking title to trust property.
11	(b) A certification of trust must be signed or otherwise
12	authenticated by one or more of the trustees. A third party may
13	require that the certification of trust be acknowledged.
14	(c) A certification of trust must state that the trust has
15	not been revoked, modified, or amended in any manner that would
16	cause the representations contained in the certification of
17	trust to be incorrect.
18	(d) A certification of trust need not contain the
19	dispositive terms of a trust.
20	(e) A recipient of a certification of trust may require the
21	trustee to furnish copies of those excerpts from the original
22	trust instrument and later amendments which designate the
23	trustee and confer upon the trustee the power to act in the
24	pending transaction.
25	(f) A person who acts in reliance upon a certification of
26	trust without knowledge that the representations contained

- 1 therein are incorrect is not liable to any person for so acting and may assume without inquiry the existence of the facts 2 contained in the certification. Knowledge of the terms of the 3 4 trust may not be inferred solely from the fact that a copy of 5 all or part of the trust instrument is held by the person
- relying upon the certification. 6

- (q) A person who in good faith enters into a transaction in reliance upon a certification of trust may enforce the transaction against the trust property as if the representations contained in the certification were correct.
- (h) A person making a demand for the trust instrument in addition to a certification of trust or excerpts is liable for damages if the court determines that the person did not act in good faith in demanding the trust instrument. A person required to examine a complete copy of the trust instrument for purposes of complying with applicable federal, state, or local law, a person acting in a fiduciary capacity with respect to a trust, and the Attorney General's Charitable Trust Bureau are deemed to be acting in good faith when demanding a copy of the trust instrument.
- (i) This Section does not limit the right of a person to obtain a copy of the trust instrument in a judicial proceeding concerning the trust.
- (j) A certification of trust may be substantially as follows, provided that nothing in this subsection (j) shall invalidate or bar the use of a certification of trust in any
